<u>Gifts Under \$5</u> (most are gifts you can make)

Pinecone with peanut butter bird feeder Ice ring luminaries you make and deliver Set of reused 5 gal plastic pails with handles Plant labels from old metal blinds or plastic milk jugs Compost tea with water, kitchen scraps and large jar Orchard mason bee house Seed keeper: make a binder with 3 hole-punched plastic ziplock bags to store seeds "Rain gardens, a how-to manual for homeowners": WI Department of Natural Resources

Gifts \$5-\$10

Birds of Wisconsin placemat Hand balm or lotion such as Badger Balm or a cranberry based lotion "Pesticide free zone" sign made of metal with large ladybug image or safe lawn sign Organic or local maple syrup, honey or jams

Gifts \$10-\$25

Hanging plant pulley Long lasting clay soap (pumice-like terra cotta impregnated with soap) Polypropylene floating row cover for vegetables Nylon net trellis Stainless steel compost pail for kitchen counter Water siphons for indoor plant watering while you are away, ceramic with tubing Self watering frog or squirrel to drip water on houseplants while you are away Siphon mixer that connects to hose to add liquid fertilizer to your water Bat house (build yourself from plans or buy one for more money) Bat guano fertilizer Noodlehead flexible sprinkler to target water only where you need it Wide brimmed hat for sun Second-hand kitchen cabinet converted into wall mounted tool storage for your garage or shed Rural mailbox mounted on post in yard to store extra set of gloves and trowel Headlamp for gardening at night Fresh local organic produce Set of "Growing -- (salad greens, tomatoes, etc) in WI" Extension publications

<u>Gifts \$25-\$50</u>

Milking stool on waist belt Manual water timer for garden hose shut-off: set dial for 5 min-2 hours and walk away Long handled diamond hoe Bulb auger for power drill Compost Tea Brewing Manual (3rd edition, by Dr. Elaine Ingham) Professional apple picker's bag Become a member of Community Car and have access to hybrid cars and a truck

<u>Gifts \$50+</u>

Gift certificate to a restaurant that promotes locally grown foods Push lawn mower Weather station: temp, rainfall, windspeed, humidity

Buy a CSA (Community Supported Agriculture) share for weekly veggies in season

If time allows: Here are more items to consider making

Aldo Leopold bench, garden record book, rain barrel, worm bin, garden trellis, mosaic stepping stones, bookmarks, potpourri, landscape plan, wreaths and garlands, cloth napkins, cloth grocery bags, soothing neck wrap, sachets, homemade soap, oil and vinegar infusions, tinctures, bath salts, window boxes, notecards

Last minute:

Certificates for services such as tool sharpening, hauling bark chips or compost, planting a container, raking, or visits to botanic gardens, or gift certificate to local plant nurseries, or a massage.
