Home Savings Bank will break ground Saturday on a branch that will incorporate environmental-conscious building techniques, such as use of recycled materials, natural lighting, a runoff-reducing rain garden and high-efficiency heating and cooling. When complete, the branch, at 3762 E. Washington Ave., will be the first bank building in Wisconsin to apply for the Leadership in Energy and Environmental Design certification from the U.S. Green Building Council.

Madison Environmental Group will combine expertise with Linville Architects, Ken Saiki Design and The Renschler Co. to build the office.
